Three bishops to lead C of E defection at Pentecost

A breakaway Church of England faction called the Ordinariate will be in place by May. According to The Times, the move to Roman Catholicism, precipitated by the C of E's acceptance of women bishops, will include at least three traditionalist bishops who will resign by Christmas. The Bishop of Fulham, the Right Rev John Broadhurst, has already said he will convert. He has accused the General Synod of being 'vindictive' and 'vicious'. The other two are the Bishop of Ebbsfleet and the Bishop of Richborough. A retired bishop, Edwin Barnes, is also likely to transfer. Many Anglican parishioners are planning to follow, including a whole parish in Folkestone – St Peter's.
